ADMISSION POLICY

TO THE APPLICANT: (**Please read before completing the application**)

All Building Trades Apprenticeship Programs are five (5) year in duration. The WDW program is four (4) years in duration. Programs are registered with the State of Florida and approved under the G. I Bill. The only cost to the apprentice is for the purchase of textbooks, which is approximately \$250.00 to \$300.00 a year. These fees are due in January of each year.

Applications for entry into these programs are accepted from June 1st through May 31st for consideration of acceptance into the program with training beginning in August.

Applications are accepted without regard to race, religion, sex or national origin. All applicants must be eighteen (18) years of age or older and must have a high school diploma or earned their GED. The Joint Apprenticeship Committee holds oral interviews for all programs on an as needed basis. All applications must be returned completed before they will be considered for oral interview.

All applications must include a certified copy of your high school transcripts or GED scores as well as a copy of your driver's license before your application can be processed.

Please print all information on your application. Make sure your telephone number and address are correct. If you move at any time, you will need to provide the JAC office with the updated address. Be sure to sign the application on the three (3) required spaces.

If you are accepted into one of these programs, the following rules shall be adhered to at all times:

1. There will be no alcoholic beverages or un-prescribed drugs allowed on the school premises at any time unless approved by the Joint Apprenticeship Committee or Training Director.
2. You shall attend related classes six (6) hours per week, as scheduled by the Training Director. The only excused absences shall be those covered by a Doctors' Certificate or a death in the immediate family. Any other may be cause for dismissal.
3. You shall maintain a passing grade average or be dismissed from the program.
4. You must attend work on time. If you are fired or quit your job, you will not be placed on another job without Joint Apprenticeship Committee approval.
5. Purchase of books is the responsibility of the apprentice. Books will be issued as needed and must be paid for prior to the end of January of your training year.

If you feel you are unable to adhere to any of these rules, please do not apply for these programs.

There are two copies of this letter included with your application. Please sign both letters and return one copy with your application and keep the other for your own records.

 3. Be a high school graduate or have obtained a GED.
 4. Applications must be complete and returned in a timely fashion.

IF YOU ARE ACCEPTED FOR APPRENTICESHIP YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

1. Serve as a probationary apprentice for a period of 1 year (1700-2000 hours of on the job training).
2. Serve a 4 or 5 year apprenticeship including the probationary period (8500 - 10,000 hours of on the job training).
3. Report to work on time on a regular basis.
4. Provide for your transportation to and from the job site.
5. Work under the direction of a Journey Worker on the job site and perform all job duties satisfactorily.
6. Attend related training classes regularly and maintain an acceptable average in those classes.
7. Purchase text material for use in related training classes as required.
8. Abide by all rules and regulations of the Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee.
